SUBJECT: SPONSORSHIP FOR 2016 BROKEN HILL GEM AND MINERAL SHOW 11/117

Recommendation

That Broken Hill City Council Report No. 77/16 dated March 24, 2016, be received.

That Council approve \$2,875.00 financial assistance to the Broken Hill Mineral Club for the hire of the Memorial Oval and Showground Adkin Pavilion and the printing of promotional posters and invitations for the Broken Hill Gem and Mineral Show to be held on September 30 to October 2, 2016.

Executive Summary:

The Broken Hill Mineral and Gem Show volunteer committee has requested cash and in-kind support to assist with promotion and venue hire charges for the 2016 Broken Hill Gem and Mineral Show "Rock On" valued at \$2,875.00. The event will be held from September 30 – October 2, 2016 at the Memorial Showground and Adkin Pavilion.

Report:

The Broken Hill Gem and Mineral Show "Rock-On" is a bi-annual festival for mineral, gemstone and lapidary enthusiasts to visit Broken Hill and buy, sell or trade minerals, gemstones and lapidary items.

The event promotes Broken Hill's status as a mineralogically diverse region and provides the opportunity to activate the City's National Heritage status by providing a focus on the Broken Hill deposit that has international recognition as one of the world's great "mineralogical rainforests".

The event also offers guided field trips throughout the surrounding region and attracts visitors from across Australia. In 2014, visitors from Adelaide, Melbourne, Sydney and Mildura attended. An average of 600 people attend the three day event.

Event organisers initially approached Council for in-kind assistance to print posters and invitations that issued Australia-wide to Mineral and Gem groups. The cost of this is estimated to be \$500.00. This report also requests financial assistance for the hire of the Memorial Oval (\$1,875.00) and Showground Adkin Pavilion (\$1,500.00) for 2.5 days at a total cost of \$2,375.00.

The total request for assistance for the event is \$2,875.00.

Financial Implications:


Funding of this request will be made available from Council's event sponsorship allocation of which there is \$33,000.00 funds remaining for the 2015/16 financial year.
