Summary

Councillor Page submitted a Notice of Motion on April 20, 2018 regarding Standing Committees of Council, which reads:

“That the Council pass a motion of no confidence in Mayor Darriea Turley, on the grounds that she did not honour her election promise to introduce the standing committees of Council.

No standing committees have left Councillors with very little say in the decision making processes of Council and this had led to the community having no say in the decisions that are made at Council Meetings.

This coupled with the fact that Council has only one public question time where speakers can only speak on agenda items and notice must be given means that the community rarely speak at Council Meetings and thus the community has even less input.

The Mayor’s failure to introduce the standing committees has meant that Councillors have little involvement in setting the budget and involvement is now limited to a presentation from the Council management.

As a Council I regret having to take this action but see no way forward and I am concerned that taking no action will result in a poor future outcome for the city.”
