

BROKEN HILL REGIONAL ART GALLERY – APPRAISALS POLICY

Purpose

To provide members of the public with an opportunity to have informal appraisals conducted on art works.

Scope

1. The Art Gallery Manager will be available by appointment during opening hours Monday to Friday to answer enquiries where feasible and within the available resources regarding the date of origin, probable function of, relative artist's importance and condition of the material of works of art.

General Principles

1. Each request for appraisal must be accompanied by a signed declaration form, example appended hereto. Alternatively: The appraisal may be accompanied, at the Manager's discretion, by a written reference to appropriate and accurate sources and avenues for further research.
2. No estimate of the monetary value of the work will be given.
