### WHAT CAN I PUT IN THE GREEN WASTE BIN?

- ✓ Grass clippings, leaves and small pruning
- ✓ Flowers, bedding plants (remove all excess soil)
- ✓ Food scraps and peels (no meat or dairy)
- ✓ Tea bags/tea leaves
- ✓ Coffee grounds and paper filters
- ✓ Paper and Cardboard

### WHAT MUST NOT BE PUT IN THE GREEN WASTE BIN?

- ✗ No large branches
- ✗ No car batteries
- ✗ No plastic bags or plastic
- ✗ No general garbage or kitty litter
- ✗ No glass of any sort
- ✗ No personal hygiene products, nappies or sharps (needles)
- ✗ No construction, demolition or earth materials
- ✗ No hazardous waste
- ✗ No hot ashes or cigarette butts

### BIN PLACEMENT

It is important that your bins are placed for collection as described below:

- Place your bin on the verge (½ metre from the kerb) with the wheels facing your house
- Ensure that it is not under a tree canopy or placed near a parked vehicle
- Allow ½ metre distance between your green waste bin and your domestic mobile garbage bin

### ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH TIPS

To get the best from your bio insert bin and the collection service, it is advisable to follow these steps:

- Store your bin in a shaded area

- Clean your bin regularly using hot soapy water
- Put lawn clippings on top of the material in your bin to prevent jamming
- Report any bin damage or theft immediately to Customer Relations on 8080 3300

### COUNCIL'S WASTE MANAGEMENT FACILITY

Located at Wills Street, Broken Hill

#### Hours of Operation:

- 8am to 4pm - Weekdays and weekends
- 8am to 2pm - Public Holidays (including Council Picnic Day)
- Closed: Good Friday, Anzac Day and Christmas Day

### OTHER RECYCLING SERVICES

Broken Hill City Council has established a "drop off" facility at its landfill where residents can drop off materials for recycling and reuse.

A second-hand shop operates at the landfill with goods for sale. Other materials that can be recycled at the landfill include:

- Whitegoods
- Steel
- Batteries
- Cans and bottles
- Cardboard
- Steel drums
- Timber
- Lawn clippings
- Uncontaminated green waste

Please separate these materials into the designated areas so that they can be recycled and reused.



**Always remember to cover your load**
