## Waste Management Facility Recycling

Recycle at the Broken Hill Waste Management Facility, situated at the end of Wills Street, for free.

Drop off all your:

- **Cardboard**
- **Timber**
- **Metals**
- **White goods**
- **Glass/bottles**
- **Oils/oil filters**
- **Green waste**

## Community Recycling Centre

The Broken Hill Waste Management Facility provides a Community Recycling Centre.

Not all waste can be put in your kerbside bins. The Community Recycling Centre offers a free and easy solution for the disposal of household problem waste such as paints, gas bottles, motor oils, batteries, smoke detectors and fluorescent globes and tubes.

## Problem Waste For Recycling

The following items can be dropped off for recycling:

- **Gas bottles**
- **Fire extinguishers**
- **Paint**
- **Fluoro globes and tubes**
- **Car batteries**
- **Household batteries**
- **Motor oils**
- **Other oils**
- **Smoke detectors**

Only household quantities accepted 20kg or 20L maximum container size.

## Where to Recycle in Broken Hill

**Channing's Bottle Yard** - A 10 cent refund is available on a range of products including milk cartons, juice cartons and tetra packs, soft drink cans and bottles. Steel cans and glass are accepted for recycling free of charge.

**Mobile Phones** - Can be recycled at Council's Administrative Centre, any Australia Post Office and the Telstra Shop.

**Printer Cartridges** - Can be recycled at Council's Administrative Centre and any Australia Post Office.

**Clean Clothes and Household Items** - Can be dropped off at various charity stores in Broken Hill; helping people less fortunate.

## Council Services Helping You Reduce Your Waste

- Weekly General Waste collection service.
- Fortnightly Green Waste collection service.
- Waste collection events held annually.
- Free Waste Management Facility drop-off for household waste. Large volume of household waste (over 1 tonne) will attract a fee. Fees also apply for businesses, contaminated waste industrial waste and waste tyres.
